<b>Statewide</b>		
<b>NH SAS – ELA/Mathematics</b> NH Statewide Assessment System	3 – 8 Spring	English Language Arts/Reading (2 hrs) English Language Arts/Writing (1.5 hrs) Mathematics (2 hrs) Standards-based, computer administered, adaptive tests aligned to the NH Academic Standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics. These assessments are unique to NH and can be adjusted to meet NH’s needs.
<b>NH SAS - Science</b> NH Statewide Assessment System	5 & 8 Spring	Science (2 hrs) Standards-based aligned with the NH Academic Standards for Science. This assessment is taken on the computer.
<b>Dynamic Learning Maps</b> **Students with significant cognitive abilities. Based upon IEP.	3 - 8 Spring	English Language Arts/Reading (30 – 45 minutes) English Language Arts/Writing (30 – 45 minutes) Mathematics (30 – 60 minutes) Science (45 – 135 minutes) Students are assessed on grade level specific expectations about what students with significant cognitive disabilities should know and be able to do.

<b>NWEA MAP Growth</b> (Northwest Evaluation Association – Measures of Academic Progress Growth)	K – 8 Fall, Winter, Spring	Reading & Mathematics (9 hrs total for the year) Computer adaptive assessment that adjusts to each student’s responses. Can track growth through the school year and over multiple years.
<b>DIBELS</b> Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills	K-5 Fall, Winter, Spring	Reading Fluency (15 minutes/year) Short (1 minute) fluency measures used to regularly monitor the development of early reading skill.
